Dear visitors,

In compliance with the government advisory board and in the context of current health crisis of Coronavirus epidemic The Carnac Prehistory Museum Has changed the visit direction and the services provided to visitors. In order for each person to enjoy their visit and uphold health and safety, we would be grateful if you would respect the following regulations.

- Inside the museum buildings, **wearing a mask is compulsory** for all visitors from 10 years and above
- Hand sanitizer is at your disposal at the entrance to the museum
- In order to comply with social-distancing measures, the museum has organized access to the rooms by timeslot per 14 visitors every 20 minutes. The museum reserves the right to limit access to the rooms temporarily in order to regulate the numbers of people present in each space at any given time.
- You will be required to pre-reserve your visit by timeslot on the museum website : <https://www.museedecarnac.com/pre-reservez-votre-visite-libre> (please include all visitors including children and babies, your visit will only be available at the time of reservation)
- Purchases at the gift shop will be by contactless bank card where at all possible. We would also ask you not to touch the items which you do not intend to buy.
- During your visit we would ask that you follow the instructions in the museum rooms, which are meant to help organize the directions of the visit in order to avoid mingling and bumping into groups of people.
- In general we must ask you to respect the rule of social-distancing o at least 1 metre between people except family groups.
- The lift is reserved for persons with reduced mobility, pushchairs and accompanying persons.
- Several museum services have been postponed in order to guarantee your security, these include :
 - Guided visits, workshop and conferences
 - Toilets
 - Play area

The videone room, has been limited to a maximum of 6 seated visitors at any one time
