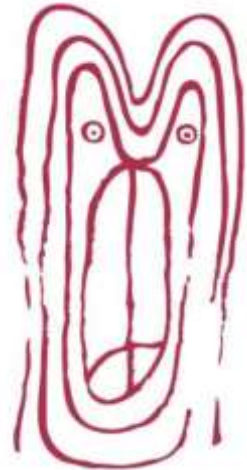


Go to the first room:
